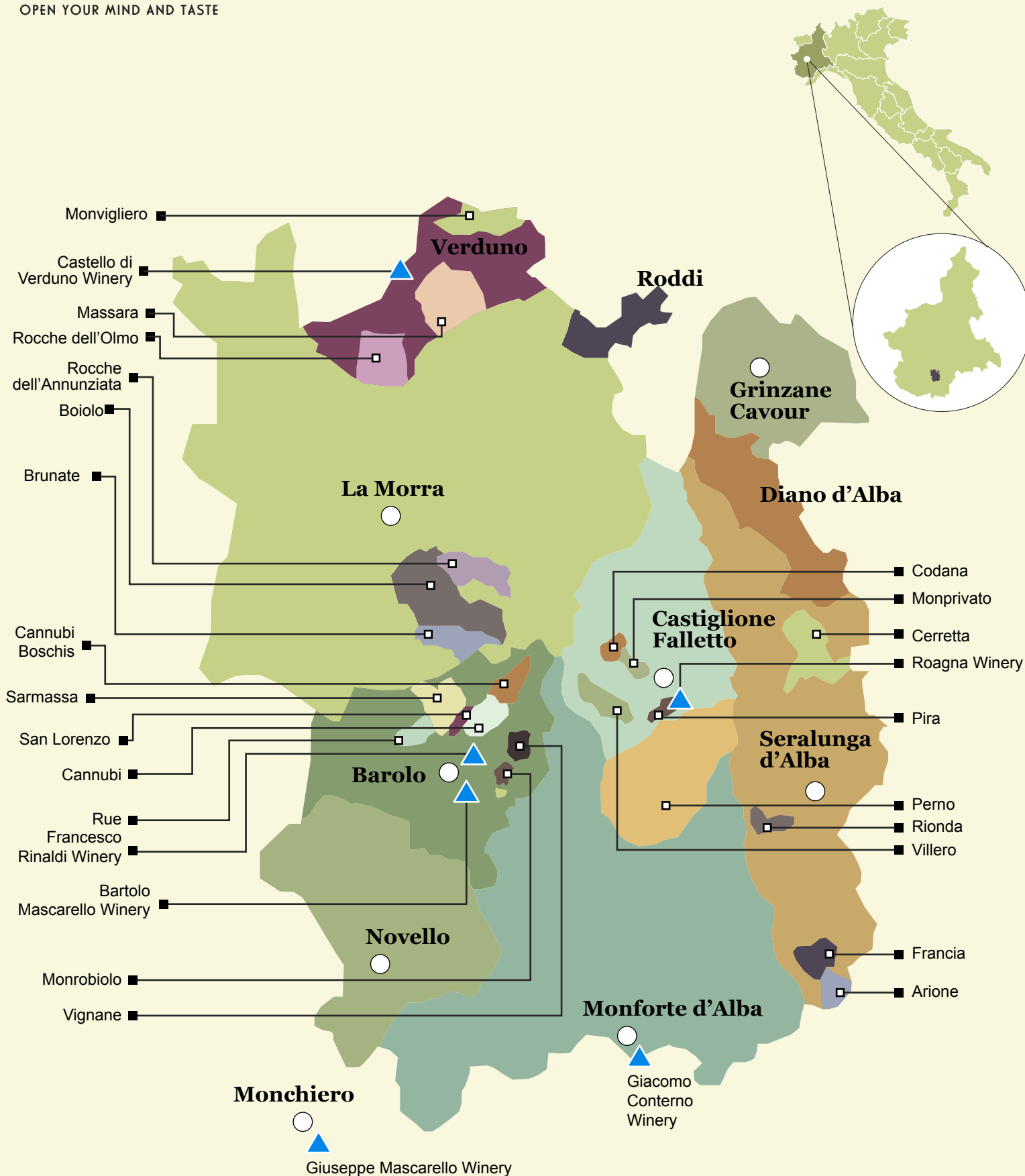

Bartolo Mascarello Winery

- Rue is a source for the Barolo (.5 hectare) as well as a source for the Dolcetto d'Alba
- San Lorenzo is a source for the Barolo (.25 hectare) as well as the source for the Barbera d'Alba
- Cannubi is a source for the Barolo (1 hectare)
- Rocche dell'Anunziata is a source for the Barolo (1.2 hectare)
- Monrobiolo is a source for the Dolcetto d'Alba

Francesco Rinaldi Winery

- Cannubi Boschis is the source for the Barolo Cannubi
- Brunate is the source for the Barolo Brunate
- Cannubi, Sarmassa, Vignane, Codana, Rocche dell'Anunziata and Boiolo are sources for the Barolo
- Roussot is a parcel within the Cannubi cru and is the source for the Dolcetto d'Alba Roussot

Giuseppe Mascarello Winery

- Monprivato is the source for the Barolo Monprivato and the Barolo Monprivato Ca' d'Morissio
- Perno is the source for the Barolo Stanto Stefano di Perno, Barbera d'Alba Santo Stefano di Perno, Barbera d'Alba Scudetto
- Codana is the source for the Barbera d'Alba Codamonte
- Toetto is the source for the Langhe Freisa Toetto – it is an unclassified vineyard near Monprivato in Castiglione Falletto
- Villero is the source for the Barolo Villero

Giacomo Conterno Winery

- Francia is the source for the Barbera d'Alba Francia, Barolo Francia and Barolo Monfortino
- Cerretta is the source for the Barbera d'Alba Cerretta and the Barolo Ceretta

Roagna Winery

- Pira is the source for the Barolo Pira, Barolo Pira Vecchie Viti, Barbera d'Alba
- Rionda is the source for the Barolo Rionda

Castello di Verduno Winery

- The Rocche dell'Olmo vineyard is the source for the Pelaverga for the Bellis Perennis
- Rocche dell'Olmo and Massara are the sources for the Pelaverga for the Basadone
- Massara is the source for the Barolo Massara
