


2010 Burgundy Part II

A "Must Have" Vintage of Elegance, Purity and Transparency

The 2010 Burgundy vintage has turned out to be something truly special. A cold, long winter resulted in late flowering with nervous vignerons up and down the Côte d'Or. Fortunately, Burgundy experienced a lovely, warm stretch of sunshine until late July that carried into August. September brought northerly winds, cooler nights and most importantly, more sunshine. The 2010 harvest occurred under ideal conditions. The low crop load and high percentage of shot berries resulted in full ripeness and great skin to juice ratio.

For the reds, the 2010 vintage is marked by freshness, remarkable site transparency and elegance. The wines have excellent concentration with crystal-



line focus, impressive structure and tremendous purity. At the entry level, many wines over-deliver and among their cru counterparts, there is great promise for longevity.

For Côte d'Or whites, balance and precision are the first words to come to mind. Aromatics range from crisp green apple to some exotic notes. The density of flavor combined with a classic mineral acidity makes for a very fine vintage for white Burgundy.

The only downside to the vintage is its scarcity. With yields down 30-50% in most areas, wine quantities are extremely limited. Please note: no order is final until confirmed by the office. Order deadline is Mon, Sept. 10, 2012.

Boisson-Vadot, Pierre Boisson & Anne Boisson - November Arrival

Domaine Boisson-Vadot is an outstanding small estate and a rising star quietly producing stellar examples of textbook Meursault. Run by the father and son team of Bernard and Pierre Boisson, the pair sticks to tried-and-true, traditional methods in the vineyard and cellar. Bernard's daughter Anne has recently added a third Meursault to the offering. Like the "Big Three" in Meursault (Côche, Lafon, Roulot), they believe in an extended élévage of 18 months. These are pure, stellar white burgs for the ages!

Camus-Bruchon - October Arrival

Lucien Camus is one of the very finest red winemakers in the Côte de Beaune. Located in the village of Savigny-les-Beaune, just to the north of Beaune proper, he fashions beautifully balanced, deep and complex wines that are the epitome of what great Burgundy is all about. Monsiur Camus is a middle-aged and vigorous gentleman who took over for his father in 1971, and has a lovely spread of top vineyards in Savigny-les-Beaune. Lucien's son Guillaume has recently taken the reigns and like his father and so many of the very best producers in Burgundy, it is very clear that he spends the lion's share of his time out in the vineyards tending his vines. There is a notably high percentage of very old vines in the Camus-Bruchon portfolio, and from these venerable vines hail some of the classiest examples of Savigny-les-Beaune to be found in Burgundy with the 2010 vintage, Camus started using partial wholecluster on his various Savigny cuvees with remarkable results. These are some of the finest we've seen from the estate.

Paul Chapelle et Filles - In Stock

After making a name for himself as a consulting enologist for some of the very best estates in the all of the Côte de Beaune (DeMontille, Pousse D'or, Lafon, etc.), Paul Chapelle founded the domaine in 1976. Paul Chapelle's daughter, Christine Beck Chapelle, has re-immersed herself in the family business and today oversees all aspects of the domaine. Vineyard holdings in Puligny-Montrachet, Meursault and Santenay are farmed sustainably and yields are kept very low. Chapelle's 2010s were fermented and aged in mostly neutral oak and capture the racy, minerally side of these appellations, including Meursault.

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Jean-Philippe Fichet - In Stock

Fichet's methods reflect his philosophy: he is famously meticulous and abhors taking short cuts. His low yields, the foremost key to quality, are achieved through severe winter pruning rather than by green harvesting. And he believes the expressiveness of his wines is enhanced through a patient 18 month élévage, with no new oak starting in 2010, and as usual minimal less stirring Jean-Philippe is extremely happy with his 2010s. The wines are luscious and "Meursault-y", with vibrant, racy acids and minerals buried in a core of fruit.

Fontaine-Gagnard - In Stock

This famous domaine of almost 20 acres, based primarily in Chassagne-Montrachet, was established in 1985 when Gagnard-Delagrange separated into two estates. The wines are made by Richard Fontaine, one of the most exacting vignerons in all of Chassagne. Richard is joined in the vineyards and the cellar by his daughter Céline. They apply traditional methods and the cleanest possible techniques, including a restrained use of new oak to emphasize the unique qualities of the individual terroirs.

Jean-Hughes et Ghislaine Goisot - In Stock

Saint-Bris is located just outside of Chablis, but shares the same Kimmeridgian limestone soils as its neighbor. Goisot's viticulture is certified biodynamic with great pains taken to produce as natural an environment as possible for the vines. Yields are also kept very low, resulting in a bevy of beautifully-made wines that have a very strong following in France and offer absolutely brilliant price-quality rapport.

Hubert & Olivier Lamy - In Stock

Hubert Lamy is considered by most to be the benchmark producer in St. Aubin. Olivier Lamy, Hubert's son, took over the winemaking in 1992 and has raised the bar even higher at this estate. He began experimenting with 600-liter tonneaux rather than all 225-litre barriques, thereby emphasizing the refined, racy terroir. Olivier's 2010s have bracing acids, minerals and cut, akin to the racy 2007 vintage, combined with a gorgeous ripeness of fruit.

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Lignier-Michelot - In Stock

In 2007 Virgile Lignier began using 25-50% whole clusters in his various cuvées, which he feels adds additional delineation and structure to his beautifully textured wines. His range of Villages offerings is quite spectacular, each wine possessing beautiful concentration and terroir definition. Virgile's 2010s are among the best wines he has ever made.



Gilbert Picq - In Stock

Very classic with an inimitable expression of minerality, racy acidity and the depth that comes with low yields, meticulous winemaking and fine parcels of vines. All the wines are fermented with natural yeasts and raised in stainless steel to protect the underlying expression of terroir. Picq's 2010s have a beautiful, chalky minerality. He feels they will age beautifully and so has bottled more than the usual quantity of magnums for his personal cellar!
