



## Fèlsina

### *Special Library Release of Fontalloro & Rancia*

Fèlsina is one of the great estates in Tuscany and one of the most famous properties in all of Italy. The winery was founded in 1966, though it didn't start bottling under the Fèlsina label until the early 1980's. Unlike most other top estates in the region, Fèlsina's Chianti Classicos as well as its IGT, Fontalloro, are all based on the purity, sanctity and complexity of Sangiovese in mono-cépage. The entire estate is now farmed organically and in some cases biodynamically (Rancia), though they have no plans to get certified.



Fontalloro is sourced from vineyards that straddle the border between Chianti Classico and the Chianti Colli Senesi appellations. It is aged in a mix of both new and used barriques for 18-22 months. In its youth it is richer and more forward than Rancia yet it ages beautifully as well. Rancia, from a high elevation cru on the estate, tends to be more

tightly wound in its youth – and develops great length and elegance with bottle age. It too sees barriques, but for a shorter period – 16-18 months and with a lower percentage of new wood. We are happy to offer this rare opportunity to acquire some cellar treasures direct from the winery!
