## Think Pink. Drink Pink.

### France

<b>Saint-Ser Côtes de Provence Sainte Victoire Rosé 2014</b>	<b>FSS008</b>	<b>\$160</b>	<b>152/5</b>	<b>Mar</b>

*A blend of Grenache, Cinsault, Syrah and Rolle (Vermentino), this provençal pink is tank-fermented after a short maceration, lending a lovely bright pink color and an enticing nose of little red berries with a touch of watermelon and lemon peel. Fuller-bodied, with good acid balance and the presence to stand up to food.*

<b>Sylvain Bailly Sancerre Rosé La Louée 2014</b>	<b>FBY020</b>	<b>\$184</b>	<b>176/5, 168/10</b>	<b>Mar</b>
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*Salmon pink with fruity aromas of grapefruit, bright acidity and a mineral core. A Polaner staff favorite year-in-and-year-out!*

<b>Gerard Boulay Sancerre Rosé 2014</b>	<b>FBL192</b>	<b>\$240</b>	<b>220/5</b>	<b>Mar</b>
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*Unlike many Sancerre rosés, Gerard harvests his Pinot specifically to make rosé by direct press, then into tank. It is not a selection of young vines as he has no young Pinot vines. The wine boasts hints of cherry and almond and finishes with an invigorating, citric brightness and chalky intensity.*

<b>Moulin de Gassac Guilhelm Rosé 2014</b>	<b>FGS040</b>	<b>\$104</b>	<b>88/5, 80/10</b>	<b>In-Stock</b>
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*From the Jurassic limestone slopes of the Gassac estate comes this pleasant pink with an intense nose of strawberries and full red fruit flavors on the palate.*

<b>Ch. La Canorgue Luberon Rosé 2014</b>	<b>FCN013</b>	<b>\$144</b>	<b>136/5</b>	<b>Mar</b>
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*This biodynamically farmed rosé is packed with fraise du bois (wild strawberries), provençal herbs and minerals. It is marked by exceptional elegance and finesse.*

<b>Chais St Laurent Chinon Rosé 2014</b>	<b>FCL109</b>	<b>\$104</b>	<b>96/5, 88/10</b>	<b>Mar</b>
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*Fruity, floral notes on the nose. Palate is fresh and bright with notes of cherry & earth. Great aperitif and lovely salmon pairing.*

<b>Francois Chidaine Touraine Rosé 2014</b>	<b>FCD176</b>	<b>\$128</b>	<b>120/5, 112/10</b>	<b>Mar</b>
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*50% Pinot Noir and 50% Grolleau from a combination of biodynamically farmed estate fruit and purchased fruit. Floral nose with hints of currants, along with the excellent acidity and mineral undertones we've come to expect in Chidaine wines!*

<b>Isle Saint-Pierre Bouches-du-Rhone Rosé 2014</b>	<b>FIS006</b>	<b>\$88</b>	<b>80/5, 72/10</b>	<b>In-Stock</b>
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*An exceptional value in Southern French rosé! This organically farmed blend of Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Arinarnoa and Petit Verdot is grown on an island in the middle of the Rhone River. It is fresh, zippy and perfect for leisurely sipping or kicking off a meal.*

### Argentina

<b>Crios Rosé of Malbec Mendoza 2014</b>	<b>RCR042</b>	<b>\$120</b>	<b>112/5, 104/10</b>	<b>In-Stock</b>
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*This all Malbec rosé has beautiful aromas of fresh, ripe watermelon. On the palate, the flavors of strawberries and young cherries come rushing in, accompanied by some spice notes and a clean, dry finish.*

This wine uses an old Champagne technique of adding lees to the wine to strip color giving it a beautiful pink hue. The Glass drinks well now but also ages similarly to a rosé Champagne.

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### Sean Minor 4B Vin Gris Carneros 2014

100% Pinot Noir from Carneros the wine has a vibrant, bright pink color with strawberry, cranberry and watermelon aromas. The palate displays bright strawberry and tart cherry flavors and has good length and crisp acidity to finish.

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### Donkey & Goat Grenache Rosé Isabel's Cuvee 2014

The much anticipated release of the 2014 Donkey & Goat Rose was made from 100 year old Grenache Gris vines. 50% was fermented as a white wine (pressed into neutral oak barrels) and 50% was left to soak on the skins for 44 hours. The final blended rose has layers of red fruits, melon and citrus that are juicy while at the same time restrained by the slight tannins and nice acid.
