France

Isle Saint-Pierre Bouches-du-Rhone Rosé 2015

An exceptional value in Southern French rosé! This organically farmed blend of Merlot, Cabernet Franc, Arinarnoa and Petit Verdot is grown on an island in the middle of the Rhone River. It is fresh, zippy and perfect for leisurely sipping or kicking off a meal.

Moulin de Gassac Guilhelm Rosé 2015

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From the Jurassic limestone slopes of the Gassac estate comes this pleasant pink with an intense nose of strawberries and full red fruit flavors on the palate (50% Grenache, 50% Carignan).

Domaine de Sulaize Aix en Provence Rosé Pomponette 2015

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As classic (and coveted!) as Provence pink gets! A blend of Grenache, Syrah, Cinsault, Mourvedre and Vermentino (Rolle), this biodynamically farmed rosé is pale pink in color and opens with bright and clear aromatics. Notes of citrus dominate, especially blood orange, followed by hints of lavender and minerals. The Rolle gives a raciness that keeps you coming back for more! Don't wait as there is never enough to go around.

Saint-Ser Côtes de Provence Sainte Victoire Rosé 2015

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A blend of Grenache, Cinsault, Syrah and Rolle (Vermentino), this provençal pink is tank-fermented after a short maceration, lending a lovely bright pink color and an enticing nose of little red berries with a touch of watermelon and lemon peel. Fuller-bodied, with good acid balance and the presence to stand up to food.

Ch. La Canorgue Luberon Rosé 2015

FCN014	\$144	136/5, 128/10	Mar
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This biodynamically farmed rosé is packed with fraise du bois (wild strawberries), provençal herbs and minerals. It is marked by exceptional elegance and finesse (70% Syrah, 30% Grenache).

Maison Foucher Chais St Laurent Chinon Rosé 2015

FCL111	\$104	96/5, 88/10	Mar
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Fruity, floral notes on the nose. Palate is fresh and bright with notes of cherry & earth. Great aperitif and lovely salmon pairing.

Francois Chidaine Touraine Rosé 2015

FCD190	\$128	112/5, 104/10	Late Mar
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50% Pinot Noir and 50% Grolleau from a combination of biodynamically farmed estate fruit and purchased fruit. Floral nose with hints of currants, along with the excellent acidity and mineral undertones we've come to expect in Chidaine wines!

Vieux Pruniers Sancerre Rosé 2015

FVP008	\$168	160/5, 152/10	Mar
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From the chalky, clay soils around the famed village of Bué comes this floral, fresh and racy Sancerre Rosé made with 100% Pinot Noir. This is our first time working with the Thirot family's delicate pink and we are thrilled to share it with you!

Sylvain Bailly Sancerre Rosé La Louée 2015

FBY023	\$184	176/5, 160/10	Mar
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Salmon pink with fruity aromas of grapefruit, bright acidity and a mineral core. A Polaner staff favorite year-in-and-year-out!

Gerard Boulay Sancerre Rosé 2015

FBL203	\$240	220/5	Late Mar
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Unlike many Sancerre rosés, Gerard harvests his Pinot specifically to make rosé by direct press, then into tank. It is not a selection of young vines as he has no young Pinot vines. The wine boasts hints of cherry and almond and finishes with an invigorating, citric brightness and chalky intensity.

Muri Gries Lagrein Rosato 2015

The Muri Gries Lagrein Rosato is always one of our first rosatos in from Italy. It has fresh red fruit with an underlying minerality. Zippy and tasty!

Il Mimo shows bright watermelon fruit and crisp acidity. Great on release, it develops well with age, for this reason it is one of the few we offer year-round.

A blend of Moscato and Brachetto, sparkling with fresh raspberry flavors. Pink happiness in a bottle!
